



ART APART

Can you follow your partners instructions to recreate their work of art without looking?

YOU WILL NEED:

- Two players
- Paper X2 per player
- Coloured pens or pencils

INSTRUCTIONS

1. There is a communicator and an artist for each round. Both players start by drawing a simple picture, keeping it secret from their partner. If playing via video chat make sure your drawing isn't in view of the camera.
2. The pair then decides who will be the first communicator - the other will be the artist. Each player will have a go playing each role.
3. The communicator should describe the picture they drew in small chunks. They can't say what they've drawn; they should only describe how to draw it. **For example, the communicator can't say 'draw a window' but they could say 'draw a square, and then put a cross in the middle of it'.**
4. The artist should follow the communicator's instructions, and draw a copy of the communicator's picture.
5. The artist can ask up to three questions, to check that they have understood the communicator's instructions.
6. Once the artist has finished following the communicator's instructions, they should swap roles and play again.
7. Once the pairs have completed both drawings, they should compare the original drawings to the artists' copies.

How similar are the pictures? Are you a better listener or a better describer?
